Dr. Peter Nord is currently Vice President, Chief Medical Officer and Chief of Staff at Providence Healthcare, a rehabilitation hospital in Toronto with a focus on assisting individuals to attain their highest level of sustained independence. Dr. Nord is Attending Physician for a 40 bed Stroke Rehabilitation Unit in Providence and is also the Medical Director of the Houses of Providence, a 288-bed long term care hospital. He is an Assistant Professor at University of Toronto.

Dr. Nord is the acting Physician Champion for Alternate Level of Care through the Wait Times Information System of Ontario, and currently is leading the redevelopment of the Transitional Care Program in Ontario through the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care.

Dr. Nord trained at McMaster University and the University of Toronto. He practised in the US, holding senior leadership positions with several health systems, and was Medical Director for Blue Cross of Virginia for a number of years.
