Dr. Peter Nord

Dr. Peter Nord is currently Vice President, Chief Medical Officer and Chief of Staff at Providence Healthcare, a rehabilitation hospital in Toronto with a focus on assisting individuals to attain their highest level of sustained independence. He currently co-chairs the Rehab / CCC Expert Panel which is tasked with improving outcomes for patients in the Rehab / CCC sector, with a focus on reducing ALC rates across the province.

Dr. Nord is also the Attending Physician for a 35 bed Stroke Rehabilitation Unit in Providence and is the Medical Director of the Houses of Providence, a 288 bed long term care facility. He is also an Assistant Professor through the University of Toronto.

Dr. Nord continues as the Physician Champion for Alternate Level of Care through the Wait Times Information System of Ontario. Dr. Nord trained at McMaster University and the University of Toronto. He practised in the US, holding senior leadership positions with several health systems, and was Medical Director for Anthem Blue Cross of Virginia for a number of years.
