

Readmission to Rehab / CCC after Acute Care Stay Information Required for Readmission

When a patient is sent from a Rehab / CCC Hospital to an Acute Care Hospital there are some things to consider before the patient can return to the Rehab Facility:

A) Rehab Bed Status

In most circumstances the patient's bed at the rehab facility will be filled once the patient is admitted to acute care.
Please consult with the rehab facility to determine the status of the patient's bed.

B) Medical Stability

Please use the GTA Rehab Network Inpatient Rehab Referral Guidelines to determine medical stability

- A clear diagnosis and co-morbidities have been established.
- At the time of discharge from acute care, acute medical issues have been addressed; disease processes and/or impairments are not precluding participation in rehab program.
- Patient's vital signs are stable.
- No undetermined medical issues (e.g. excessive shortness of breath, falls, congestive heart failure).
- Medication needs have been determined.

C) Process for Readmission*

Using the Flow chart below as a Guide:

Please fax the required information to the Rehab Facility.
The Rehab Facility will then work with you regarding the arrangements for readmission

***Please note that confirmation must be received from the Rehab/CCC hospital prior to patient return from acute care**
